## What is a Parent Resource Center?

The Parent Resource Center is funded by the Title I Program. Our resource center is available to all Panter parents, grandparents, guardians, and teachers. It is a lending library designed to bridge the connection between school and home.

## The Parent Resource Center Provides:

- Activities, instructional games, and practice materials to support reading and math
- Brochures and pamphlets to help you support your child's education
- A computer and printer for parent/guardian use
- Materials to support state academic and content standards and assessments

## How are Materials Checked Out and Returned?

- Parents are welcome to come in and sign out materials or request items through teachers or the Forms link. We ask that you keep the items for a few weeks and then return them to school.
- Teachers may check out materials for students and send them home.
- Parents may request materials for a specific reading or math skill and the materials will be sent home with the student.
