Students May Qualify For McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance, If They Are Living In Any Of The Following:

McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act identifies homeless students as those who lack a **fixed, regular** and **adequate** nighttime residence. Including children and youth who:

- Share the housing of other persons due to the loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason,
- Live in motels, hotels, or camping grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
- Live in emergency or transitional shelters;
- Abandoned in hospitals;
- Children and youth who have run away from home, even if parents will provide a home);
- Throwaways (children whose parents or guardians will not permit them to live at home);
- Children and youth who live in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings;
- Migratory children who are living in circumstances listed above.
