

How Can the PRC Benefit You?

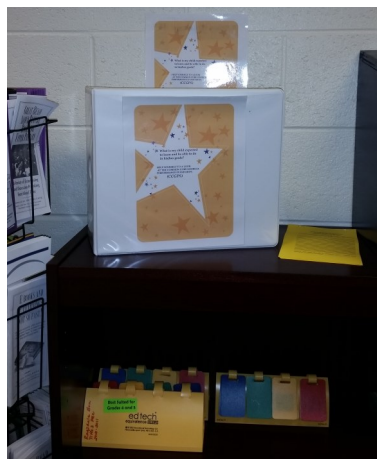
Our goal is to provide parents, grandparents, and guardians with information and resources that address their needs.
