



# Digital Learning Days

## Level 2

### OVERVIEW

For future extended school closures, we may pivot to Level 2 “Digital Learning”. Teachers will provide assignments via Canvas, our learning management system, for students to complete at home. Teachers will also hold live sessions, provide feedback, conference with students, and be available for questions through Canvas during normal work hours. The following are expectations for an extended closure.

### VIRTUAL OFFICE HOURS

- Middle/High: 10-11am or 2-3pm

### REQUIREMENTS

- All Digital Work will be housed in Canvas in a module labeled “DATE Digital Learning Day”.
- The module will be published for student access by 9:00 am on the Digital Learning Day.
- Each subject’s work will have a submission component such as quiz, discussion, or assignment

### DIGITAL ACCESS CONCERNS

- Students may request a hard copy of assignments upon return to school.
- Students will have time upon returning to school to complete assignments.
- Media Centers will be open before and after school as needed following a closure
