Graduation Practice

Wednesday May 26 and Thursday, May 27, 2020; 9:30. Report to the gym for practice. Students are expected to be at all practices. Please do not make appointments during this time. Once finished you will be dismissed. However, do not count on leaving before noon. Typically, the practice on the field is hot. Wear sunglasses, a hat and appropriate clothing. This means light colors and light weight clothing, but you must still follow the school dress code. Also, bring a bottle of water.

Tickets

Tickets for the ceremony will be distributed on **May 26** during practice. Each graduate will receive **4 tickets.** Guest may enter the stands starting at 7:00pm.

Graduation Dress

One of the things that make graduation an impressive sight is the uniformity of student dress. Under the gowns, girls should wear white dresses and boys should wear khaki pants and a white shirt with a tie. Girls' shoes should be white heels or sandals, but we suggest you choose low heels because the field may be wet or the turf uneven and it could be difficult to walk. Boys should wear dark dress shoes. Please, no jeans, tennis shoes or flip flops. If you do not own the required items, you might consider borrowing them. You need them for only an hour and very little of them show so they do not need to be brand new. **No sunglasses.**
