## Graduation Tickets

Tickets for the ceremony will be distributed on **May 25** during practice. Each honor graduate will receive six tickets. This will allow six honor graduate guests to sit on the track. All other guests will sit in the stands and may enter starting at 6:30am.

## Graduation Dress

One of the things that make graduation an impressive sight is the uniformity of student dress. Under the gowns, girls should wear white dresses and boys should wear khaki pants and a white shirt with a tie. Girls' shoes should be white heels or sandals, but we suggest you choose low heels because the field may be wet or the turf uneven and it could be difficult to walk. Boys should wear dark dress shoes. Please, no jeans, tennis shoes or flip flops. If you do not own the required items, you might consider borrowing them. You need them for only an hour and very little of them show so they do not need to be brand new. **No sunglasses. You MAY NOT decorate your cap and/or gown!!!**

## Your Name on the Graduation Program

Every effort is made to include every graduate's name on the program. However, the school must meet the printer's deadline if the programs are to be printed in time for the ceremony. If there are any issues with your grades that put your graduation status in question, it may result in your name not appearing on the program. It is very important, therefore, that you do not let any assignments, tests or obligations wait until the last minute. If all of your academic obligations have not been completed by 4:00 on **Monday, May 23** your name may not be on the program.
