VIRTUAL HIGH SCHOOL FAQ

Transitioning from Face to Face instruction to Virtual Instruction

- 1. Students who have requested and been accepted will transition from face to face instruction to virtual instruction will begin classes on Monday August 17.
- 2. Students will be able to view their virtual schedule in parent portal prior to August 17th as we prepare the courses. The students are not required to begin working on the classes until August 17th.
- 3. Students should continue working on their face to face classes until the August 17th transition.

Schedule Changes

Schedule change may occur during the first ten days of the school semester. Contact your home school counselor to make a schedule change request. Once the counselor reviews the schedule change it will be processed if approved.

Virtual Class times

The virtual schedule looks different in Parent Portal compared to the Face to Face classroom schedule. It may appear that more than one class is occurring at the same time. The actual class times are listed in the home page of each Canvas course. The home page houses lesson times, tutoring times, teacher information, and any pertinent links. Students are able to access their classes 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Virtual Instruction

Within the home page of the Canvas course, the times for live sessions will be listed. All sessions will be recorded for families that are not able to make the live sessions. Please note that courseware is designed to provide instruction. Students that wish to work ahead may do so. The live sessions are beneficial for asking questions directly; therefore, it is recommended that students attend live sessions, but it is not required. Not all courses will have live sessions, but all courses will have teacher recorded instruction a minimum of twice per week. The recorded sessions permit families to receive instruction at their convenience with the ability to review the lesson as often as they wish.

Tutoring opportunities are available to students. The information on tutoring times are available on the home page of the course in Canvas. While tutoring is not mandatory, it is highly recommended.

Students may email their teachers at any time with questions or for any additional support they may need.

Students with an IEP or 504

Students with an IEP or a 504 will continue to receive support. Please contact the student's case manager for questions regarding support services.

Schedules

Virtual Schedules within Parent Portal/Infinite Campus will look different from what you are accustomed to seeing for Face-to-Face courses. When viewing schedules within Infinite Campus / Parent Portal, you will need to select New Hope Education Center in the drop-down menu for schools to see your schedule. If you are under your home school, you will not be able to view your virtual courses. You may see classes stacked in the same section and/or at the same time; and, this is okay. The individual teachers will post the instructional/tutoring schedule in the actual Canvas course.

Canvas

Your student's classes are listed in our learning management platform, Canvas. Please look in Canvas for the scheduled times for instruction, instructional activities and assignments, and communication from your teacher. This is the link to the student dashboard page.
