Why Hiram Academy Computer Science?

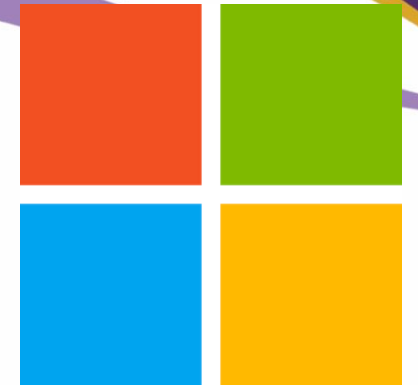
