

Student Technology Guidelines

PCSD student technology devices include computers located in computer labs, district-provided student laptops and tablets.

Personal technology devices include but are not limited to cell phones, headphones, earbuds, air pods, Bluetooth devices, non-district-provided laptops and/or tablets, gaming devices, and other similar devices.

- > PCSD STUDENT TECHNOLOGY DEVICES (COMPUTERS, LAPTOPS, OR TABLETS) SHOULD BE THE ONLY DEVICES USED WHEN STUDENTS ARE UTILIZING TECNOLOGY DURING SCHOOL HOURS.
- > TEACHERS WILL COMMUNICATE WHEN IT IS APPROPRIATE FOR STUDENTS TO UTILIZE ANY TECHNOLOGY DEVICE.
- > STUDENTS SHOULD STORE THEIR PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES (CELL PHONES, HEADPHONES, EARBUDS, AIRPODS, ETC) IN THEIR POCKETS OR PERSONAL BAGS (BOOKBAG, PURSE, STRINGBAG, ETC.).
- > PERSONAL DEVICES SHOULD NEVER BE OUT OR IN USE FOR ANY REASON IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
 - 1. HALLWAYS
 - 2. RESTROOMS
 - 3. LOCKER ROOMS
 - 4. CAFETERIA
 - 5. CLASSROOMS
 - > STUDENTS SHOULD NEVER TAKE PHOTOS, VIDEOS, OR AUDIO RECORDINGS OF ANY STUDENT, TEACHER, OR STAFF MEMBER.
- ➤ IF A STUDENT NEEDS TO CONTACT THEIR PARENT, THEY MAY REQUEST PERMISSION TO VISIT THE FRONT OFFICE TO DO SO.
