(National School Climate Council)

School climate is the social atmosphere or learning environment in which kids experience learning. Including:

- Relationships
- Personal growth or goal orientation
- System maintenance and system change.

“PBIS is an **evidence-based**, data-driven decision making **framework** for establishing the **social culture** and **behavioral supports** needed for a school to be an effective learning environment for all students and staff.”

School Mission and PBIS Alignment

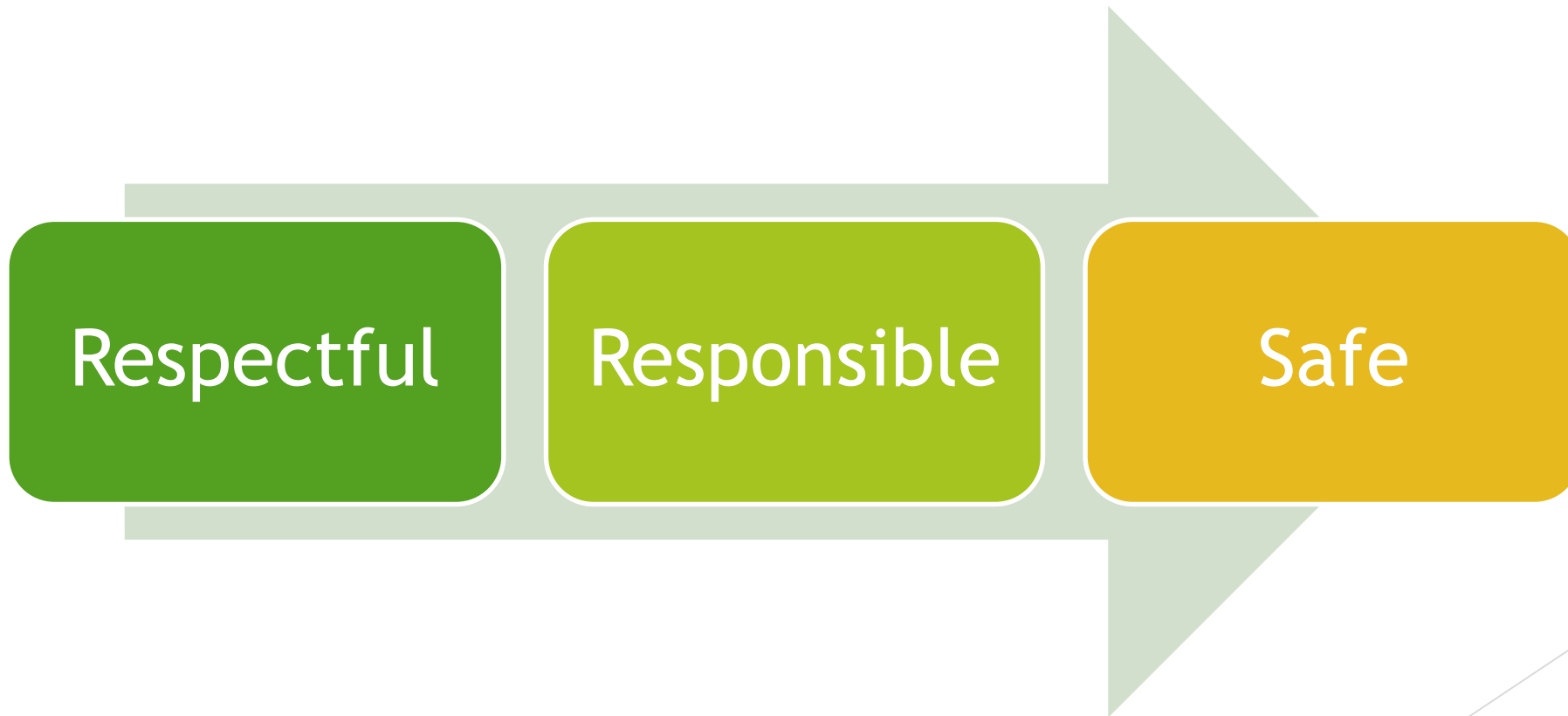
