



# Crossroads Middle School Attendance Zone Boundary Plan

East Paulding, McClure, Moses Middle Schools

<b>QUESTION</b>	<b>ANSWER</b>
<b>When will the boundary realignment take place?</b>	<i>Once the attendance boundary for Crossroads MS is finalized, the boundary will be effective in the 2024/2025 school year.</i>
<b>Will my current 7<sup>th</sup> grader be able to stay at their current middle school for their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year?</b>	<p><i>Yes. Board Policy JBCCA and Regulation JBCCA-R, outline the process for a “request to remain” as well as other school options. All requests to remain for rising 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be approved; however, transportation will not be provided.</i></p> <p><i>The “request to remain” window will open once the attendance boundary is finalized in January.</i></p>
<b>Can my rising 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup>-grade student stay at their current school?</b>	<i>Only rising 8th-grade students are eligible for the “request to remain” process; however, EPMS, McClure, and Moses Middle Schools may be open for school choice for the 24-25 school year depending on available seats.</i>
<b>Will the new attendance boundaries change where my student will attend high school?</b>	<i>No. The proposed attendance boundary adjustments will only impact middle school attendance zones.</i>
<b>Will all Crossroads Middle School students attend the same high school?</b>	<i>All students in the proposed attendance boundary for Crossroads MS are currently in the North Paulding High School attendance boundary.</i>
<b>Will students be rezoned from their current middle school to a middle school other than Crossroads Middle School?</b>	<i>The proposed attendance boundary only rezones students to Crossroads MS. Students would either be rezoned to Crossroads MS or remain in their current attendance boundary.</i>
<b>When will the final decision be made on the new attendance boundaries?</b>	<i>Final recommendations on the Crossroads MS attendance boundary will be presented to the board for approval on January 9, 2024.</i>
<b>What is the timeframe for school choice?</b>	<i>Once the final attendance boundary for Crossroads MS is complete in early January, the “Request to remain” window for rising 8th-grade students will open. Once the “request to remain” is complete, schools open for School Choice in 24/25 will be identified and the window for School Choice registration will open.</i>



<b>Will all the middle schools impacted be open for school choice next year?</b>	<i>Depending on the number of “requests to remain” for rising 8th-grade students, EPMS, McClure and Moses Middle Schools may be open for school choice for the 24/25 school year.</i>
