

EAST PAULDING CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY ACCEPTANCE OF MEMBERSHIP FOR JUNIORS

Congratulations! You have just been nominated to join one of the oldest, most prestigious national organizations for high school students. Chapters exist in more than 60% of the nation's high schools, and since 1921 millions of student scholars have been selected for membership. Moreover, millions of dollars in scholarship money has been awarded to senior members since 1945 by the sponsoring organization, The National Association of Secondary School Principals. For students who have endeavored to achieve and maintain the rigorous academic standards necessary to be considered for membership in National Honor Society, the notice of membership eligibility is a major milestone in their high school careers. Fewer than 15% of the junior and senior classes meet the requirements for consideration. While membership in National Honor Society is a true honor, it is also voluntary.

I understand that if I choose to accept membership in National Honor Society, I am obligated to specific responsibilities:

1. Maintain a 93.0 (non-rounded) GPA or above.
 2. Participate in both group service projects during Spring Semester 2021.
 3. Attend all required meetings and miss no more than two regular monthly meetings per year.
 4. Join the NHS Junior Class Remind group for updates: Text - @c38hd69 to 81010
- I understand that because I was approved for membership during the spring of my junior year, my service responsibilities will change during the fall of my senior year – I will have service hour requirements and service project requirements that all full-time members must maintain to remain eligible for membership.
 - I understand that while I have no fee requirements for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year, I will have to pay dues in August 2021 for my senior year in order to remain eligible. Additional fees are required for purchase of the NHS stole for graduation. Information on stole prices and dues will be shared at a later date.
 - I understand that if I fail in my membership responsibilities, I will be put on probation and my membership may be rescinded. I may only be on probation one time.
 - I understand that once my membership has been rescinded, I may never be reinstated.
 - I understand that I must demonstrate the highest standards of honesty, reliability, and fairness both in class and in extracurricular functions as well as comply with all school policies and regulations so as not to have a discipline referral leading to ISS (unless it is for tardies or dress code violations) or OSS or I may be subject to the revocation of my membership.
 - I understand that by joining the National Honor Society, I am subjecting myself to higher disciplinary and academic standards than other students and I agree to take any consequences with good grace.
