



East Paulding High School Parking Contract Parking Rules and Regulations . . . Please read before signing off on this contract

Parking and traffic violators on campus are subject to, but not limited to, one or more of the following disciplinary action(s) as deemed appropriate by the school administration.

- 1. Driving an automobile on the campus of East Paulding High School is a privilege. You are asked to always follow safe driving procedures. When you arrive at school, park the car (do not ride around on campus), leave the auto, and enter the building. Do not return to the auto during the day without permission and never move the auto until the close of the school day. Violation will result in disciplinary action and may warrant loss of driving privilege.
- 2. Tickets/Citations will be issued for the following offenses (all may result in loss of driving privilege):
 - a. Speeding (speed limit 15mph)
 - b. Improper use of vehicle
 - c. Illegal Parking
 - d. Driving out the entrance lanes
 - e. Pulling out in front of a school bus
 - f. Vehicles parked on campus without a decal or are not registered
- g. Failure to Stop at "Stop" signs, obey "Yield" signs, or go wrong way down a "One Way Only"
- h. Parking at a yellow curb or in a "No Parking Zone" or "Fire Lane"
- i. Parking on service Roads, driveways, or walkways
- j. Parking at an angle or in a manner to utilize two parking spaces
- Parking in incorrect spot (do not park in teacher's space, handicapped zone, grassy area, or another student's space

Parking tags are to be displayed everyday while on campus. The tags are to be displayed as recommended from the manufacture. Vehicles will be ticketed for not having tag displayed. Violations are \$10 for each ticket up to the fourth ticket. The fourth violation will result in a \$20 ticket. A parking boot may also be utilized. Suspension of parking privileges for a period of time may also be given. Repeated violations will result in a permanent loss of parking privileges. If you park on campus without purchasing a tag, a \$25 ticket will be issued for each violation. Repeated violations may result in the vehicle being towed at owner's expense. Students may also lose the privilege to purchase a tag in the future.

First and all subsequent offences may result in a fine (\$10.00), loss of parking, vehicle booted, or towed at owner's expense. No refunds will be given. Failure to respond to a citation issued by a campus police officer shall be grounds for canceling the parking decal or permit.

- 3. No decal or permit may be bought or transferred to another student by a student for any reason.
- 4. Students are not to use the service road that connects to East Paulding Middle School; doing so could result in revocation of parking privilege without refund (only Band, Tennis and Softball Athletes may travel to sport complexes located at Middle School with Coach/Instructor Supervision)
- 5. Hang Tags/Decals will be issued to students who qualify for parking privileges as determined by the principal or his/her designee.
- 6. This application for permission to park a vehicle on East Paulding's Campus carries with its permission by the applicant and/or owner to search the vehicle by the school's administration who have reasonable cause to believe the vehicle contains contraband.
- 7. Students must earn 2.5 units the previous semester to maintain the parking privilege.
- 8. Anyone damaging school property or landscaping in any manner will have a warrant sworn out on him or her for criminal damage to public property.
- 9. The driver/owner of any vehicle will be responsible for the use of his/her vehicle while on campus, and subsequently for a violation of the above rules and regulations by persons other than him/her if the offense is committed with or in his/her vehicle.
- 10. The school is not responsible for the losses or damages to the property of users of its facilities. Proof of insurance as required by state law shall be provided prior to the assignment of a parking space.
- 11. The local principal or his/her designee will suspend a student's parking privilege for two (2) weeks at the time of the 4th unexcused tardy to school.
- 12. Students may lose their driving/parking privilege if they fail to adhere to the requirements of the attendance protocol. Once entering campus, students shall not leave school grounds without the permission of a parent/guardian and the Principal or designee. Students must follow the established procedures for checking in or out of school.

Students are responsible for knowing and adhering to all parking rules and regulations as written in the Student Handbook as well as the Board of Education's policies as posted on the Paulding County School District's website.
