Commencement Information

Seniors and their parents should read all information in this packet carefully. Seniors are responsible for knowing and following all directions and schedules in this packet.

Commencement is an optional, dignified, formal ceremony for graduating seniors and their families and guests. Possession of any disruptive objects or disruptive behavior may lead to immediate removal from the ceremony.

We ask that everyone in attendance please cooperate to make the commencement ceremony the dignified event it is meant to be. Please avoid making any distracting noises that would detract from the decorum of the ceremony. The ceremony is an official function of North Paulding High School; therefore, all Paulding County School District and North Paulding High School policies and rules must be followed.

Commencement

Wednesday, May 21st, 2025, at 8:00 P.M. North Paulding High School Stadium

Senior Arrival

Graduates will need to report to the gym no later than <u>6:00 P.M</u>. for the ceremony. We are working diligently to alleviate traffic issues with one way in and one way out. Please use the left lane as you come up the hill. Graduates will be directed by parking staff as to where they are to park when they arrive for the ceremony. Please be dressed and have your cap/gown with you. Report directly to the gym for check-in. <u>Only graduates will be allowed to enter the building</u>. Please tell your family and guests to expect heavy traffic in and out of NPHS.

Commencement Parking

Graduation guests will have the use of multiple lots for parking this year. All parking areas will be open at <u>6:00 P.M.</u>; <u>PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE THIS TIME</u>. We will have parking at North Paulding High School, McClure Middle School, Burnt Hickory Elementary School, and Burnt Hickory Park located off Highway 61. The offsite lot at Burnt Hickory Park will have multiple shuttle buses that will transport you directly to the front of the stadium. <u>Buses will</u> <u>start running at 6:30 P.M</u>. Buses will also have priority when leaving campus. Carpooling is encouraged at all sites. Once a site is full, the Paulding County Sheriff's Department will restrict access to those lots. Golf cart shuttles will be available to limit walking.

Handicap Parking and Seating

For guests with a mobility issue or requiring assistance: Please report to the North Paulding campus (please display a handicap tag if you have one), turn on your hazard (flasher) lights so the parking crew can distinguish you from other vehicles and you will be directed to a specific lot. All lots on the North campus will have golf cart shuttles to assist in transporting our guests from their cars to the stadium. Please only have the person or persons requiring assistance use the carts so that others may use the service. Handicap seating will also be available for those who cannot sit comfortably in the stadium bleachers. Handicap seating will be in designated areas, but only <u>ONE</u> other person may be allowed to sit with the person in the area <u>(no children will be allowed in this area)</u>. We will try our best to accommodate the needs of our visitors.

Tickets

Each senior will be given <u>6 tickets</u>. These tickets will allow 6 ticket holders to enter either side of the stadium. <u>Only ticket holders can attend the graduation ceremony</u>. Ticket holders may begin entering the stadium at <u>7:00 P.M</u>. There are NO reserved seats or areas. Seniors will receive their 6 tickets on **Wednesday**, **May 21st** during graduation practice. Inclement Weather Plan

If inclement weather occurs the day of Commencement, the ceremony will take place in the gym and auditorium. Graduates will only receive 2 rain tickets and they will be marked as rain tickets.

General Graduation Information

Seniors must meet the following requirements for graduation before a diploma will be granted.

- Graduates must pass all required classes before graduation. The parents of any
 potential graduates who failed a class will be contacted by the teacher of record by the
 end of the day <u>Wednesday, May 14th</u>. The assigned counselor will also contact the
 student's parent to discuss alternative graduation options.
- 2. Graduates must meet all financial obligations, including senior dues, school issued laptop returned, payment for lost textbooks, library fines, etc., and be "cleared" by the bookkeeper, Michelle Dietz, before final grades can be given and before the graduate will be allowed to participate in commencement practice. Students will be notified as quickly as possible. Students will have until <u>Monday, May 19th</u>, during graduation practice to take care of any outstanding financial obligations; however, senior holds should be paid *as soon as possible* to avoid interruptions in graduation practice. *Payments for financial obligations must be made in cash, cashier's check, or money order and taken to the bookkeeper. No personal checks will be accepted.*

Commencement Practice

ATTENDANCE AT THE COMMENCEMENT PRACTICE IS A **MANDATORY** REQUIREMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY. Graduates must be on time for practice and <u>will not be admitted late or permitted to leave early.</u>

Practice Guidelines:

- Graduates are expected to follow directions explained during practice or they will be excluded from the ceremony.
- Paulding County School District policies and North Paulding High School policies, rules, and expectations are in effect at all commencement practices.
- Dress code is in effect for practice; however, gym shorts are allowed.
- Graduates must have met all financial obligations.
- Practice will end when Mr. Davies has completed everything. The more you listen and do what is necessary, the quicker we can finish.
- Students are not allowed back into the school building for any reason after practice. You must make plans to leave campus once practice is over.

Ceremony Behavior

- All policies, rules, and expectations of the school and the Paulding County School District will be enforced. Graduates must remain properly dressed throughout the ceremony.
- Possession of any disruptive objects may lead to immediate removal from the ceremony.
- Graduates should not bring valuables (cameras, phones, purses, etc.) to the ceremony. No one is available to monitor their valuables.
- Graduates must arrive on time, follow directions, and cooperate fully during the ceremony. Disruptive graduates will be removed and not allowed to participate in the ceremony.

Each graduate at NPHS deserves to hear his or her name during the graduation ceremony. The announcers cannot stop and pause for excessive noise following **one** graduate's name, or we would have to delay the ceremony. Please be respectful of the formal nature of the ceremony, but more importantly be respectful of your fellow graduates. No noise makers, beach balls, horns, or bells of any kind should be used on the field or by the audience. Please remind your parents and others planning to attend that we truly want to honor every graduate. <u>Seniors on the field can be removed for rude or obtrusive behavior.</u>

Honor Graduates

Any senior with a grade point average (GPA) of **89.5** and above will be recognized as an honor graduate. These students will receive honor medals to wear over the top of their gown. These will be distributed at graduation practice. On top of wearing the medal, these graduates are also honored by being allowed to graduate first. Honor graduates will line up alphabetically at the beginning of the line.

Valedictorian/Salutatorian

These highly esteemed positions are earned by the senior with the highest GPA and the student with the second highest GPA. These students will not only be honored with the title but will also be recognized during the ceremony and have the chance to speak to the graduating class. These students will work with Mr. Davies to write an appropriate/approved speech.

Awards Night

On <u>Tuesday, May 6th, 2025</u>, we will host senior awards night in the stadium (weather permitting) at <u>NPHS at 7:00 P.M.</u> (Students receiving awards arrive at <u>5:30</u> and report to the cafeteria) Seniors will receive invitations if they are being recognized for an award, special scholarship or being awarded an honor cord from a club or organization. Family is invited to attend to see the accolades and success of many of our seniors. Students involved in this evening will receive specific directions from club or faculty sponsor or counselor. Baccalaureate

This is a religious based service that honors the graduates. This is not a required event, but one that is planned by students and parents. The service is scheduled for **Monday, May 12th at 7:00 P.M. at Westridge Church**. Students should plan on wearing your gown. Please invite your family and friends.

Graduate Attire

Caps and gowns must be worn by graduating seniors. If you have not ordered a cap/gown, please contact Herff Jones ASAP. Please steam or hang the gown before commencement; do NOT hem or iron commencement gowns. Only those in proper attire will be allowed in the processional.

You may not alter the appearance of the cap and gown in any **way** including the top and rim of the cap. **DO NOT** under any circumstances place any numbers, letters, images, or items of any kind on the top of the mortarboard for decoration. Your tassel is your decoration.

The only addition to any cap and gown outfit will be honor recognitions. <u>Students who have</u> received cords, sashes, medals, or stoles as an honor recognition from a recognized school organization can be worn during graduation. Cords and stoles from outside organizations will not be allowed to be worn.

Ladies: Please wear a dress underneath your gowns. While you may wear heels, you must have a strap that prevents your shoes from flopping. Also, be careful of the type of heel; stiletto type heels are not allowed. These shoes are a safety hazard. They will go into the field and possibly cause you to trip, especially since we have a turf field. *Bring your shoes to practice on Tuesday and Wednesday.*

Men: Please wear dress pants, white dress shirt with a tie, and dress shoes. No shorts or jeans will be allowed. **No flip flops or tennis shoes of any kind are allowed.**

Commencement Photos

To maintain the dignity of the ceremony, guests must remain in their seats throughout the Commencement Ceremony. Family and guests will NOT be permitted in the stage area to take videos or photos. Only hand-held cameras that do not block the view of other guests may be used.

We have arranged for Cady Studios to take commencement photos (taken as students leave the stage with the diploma in hand). Cady Studios will email you the proofs for you to preview and purchase.

Diplomas

During the ceremony, students are handed the diploma cover but not the actual diploma to prevent any mix ups. Immediately following graduation ceremony, seniors will report back to the gym to pick up a packet of information including the diploma and any personal items they left behind. **ONLY seniors** will be allowed to go back in the building.

Emergency Assistance

If anyone needs assistance, faculty will be present through the stadium. We will also have Paulding County Deputies on site, along with medical professionals should an incident arise. Our field house will be used as a cooling station and/or emergency location. In addition, Paulding County Deputies will be assisting with parking, gate control, and crowd safety.

Laptop Returns

District issued laptops, laptop chargers, and laptop cases will be collected on **May 13th and May 14th**, **2025**, **from 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM** in the Media Center for graduating seniors only. See the flyer from the school district on the following page for more information.

Dear Parents,

As we approach the end of the school year, we would like to inform you about the process for returning your student's school-issued laptop. In May, we will be collecting (the) school-issued laptops from graduating students. We will collect laptops, power cords, and laptop cases from

all graduating Seniors on May 13th and May 14th from 8:00 -3:00 in the Media Center.

In addition to returning their school-issued laptop on the date listed above, students will also need to return their charger and the laptop case on that same day. All three items must be turned in on the date listed above to consider the return process complete for your child. Prior to turning in the school-issued laptop, charger, and case, any stickers or decorations placed on the laptop, charger, or case by your child must be removed. Please DO NOT remove any school barcodes or original device labels.



Should any damage be found to the school-issued laptop, charger, and/or case during the collection process, a fine will be placed on your (the) child's school account (if any damages are found) and a letter requesting payment will be sent home. Of special note for parents of students planning to graduate this spring/summer, any fines must be paid in advance of and in order to participate in graduation ceremonies.
