

STUDENT TECHNOLOGY GUIDELINES

PERSONAL TECHNOLOGY DEVICES

- Personal technology devices should **never** be out or in use for any reason.
- Personal technology devices include but are not limited to:
 - Cell Phones
 - Headphones
 - Earbuds
 - Air Pods
 - Bluetooth Devices

- Personal Laptops and/or Tablets
- Gaming Devices
- Other Similar Devices
- Smart Devices
- Students should store their personal electronic devices in their pockets or personal bags (bookbag, purse, string bag, etc.).

PCSD TECHNOLOGY DEVICES

- ➤ PCSD student technology devices should be the only devices used when students are utilizing technology during school hours.
- > District-provided technology devices may include but are not limited to:
 - Laptops
 - Tablets
 - Headphones

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- ➤ Teachers will communicate when it is appropriate for students to utilize any technology device.
- ➤ Technology devices (personal and/or district devices) should <u>never</u> be in use in the following areas.
 - Restrooms
 - Locker Rooms
- > Students should never take photos, videos, or audio recordings of any student, teacher, or staff member.
 - Exception: Teachers may grant students permission to record and/or take photos for instructional purposes only.
- ➤ If a student needs to contact their parent/guardian, they must <u>request</u> permission to visit the front office to do so.
