# Goals

ELA-We will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished levels of the ELA EOG assessment. 6<sup>th</sup> grade will increase their level 3s and 4s from 39% to 45% (13 students). 7<sup>th</sup> Grade will increase their level 3s and 4s from 45% to 51% (11 students). 8<sup>th</sup> grade will increase their level 3s and 4s from 51% to 57% (12 students).

Math-We will increase the percentage of students scoring in the proficient and distinguished levels of the Math EOG assessment at each grade level. 6<sup>th</sup> grade will increase their level 3s and 4s from 43% to 49% (13 students). 7<sup>th</sup> Grade will increase their level 3s and 4s from 40% to 46% (11 students). 8<sup>th</sup> grade will increase their level 3s and 4s from 49% to 55% (13 students).

#### **Demographics**

We have 625 students at EPMS (226 sixth graders, 195 seventh graders, and 207 eighth graders). We have a diverse population, with 22% African American, 17% Hispanic, 5% Multiracial, 1% Asian, and 54% white students (1% other). Forty-six percent of our population receives Free and Reduced Lunch.

#### Honors/Awards/Certifications

EPMS had the highest middle school CCRPI score in the county last year. We were recognized for student achievement and climate/culture. EPMS received the "Above and Beyond" award for our work with Achieve 3000. In April 2025, EPMS was recognized by State Superintendent Richard Woods for being a Math Leader.
