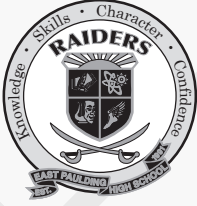


AUDIO VIDEO TECHNOLOGY & FILM

PATHWAY COURSES

▶ AVT&F I

This foundational course prepares students for careers in the film and broadcast industry by teaching employability skills, industry terms, safety and basic equipment operation.

▶ AVT&F II

This is the second course in the career pathway. In this class students demonstrate project based learning acquiring organization, leadership skills, writing, directing and editing.

▶ AVT&F III

The third and final course to complete the pathway. In this competitive learning environment students enter SkiiiUSA, student Emmy's, local, and national PSA competitions.

▶ AVT&F IV

As known as Broadcast Applications allows students to put knowledge to use. In this course students intern with broadcast professionals in the community and run an in house production company at EPHS.
