



Dear Homeschool Parents and Students,

Please read this document carefully for important information regarding AP exams at East Paulding High school. The 2026 AP Exams will be administered May 4<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup>.

East Paulding High will be administering the following AP exams this year:

English Literature and Composition

English Language and Composition

Precalculus

Statistics

Calculus

Chemistry

Human Geography

World History

US History

Psychology

Biology Spanish Language and Culture

There are several steps that must be completed to register a homeschool student to take an AP exam at East Paulding High school.

- 1) Complete the online registration form <u>HERE</u>.
- 2) Provide 2 proofs of residency in our attendance zone. Acceptable proofs of residence can be found here: https://www.paulding.k12.ga.us/Page/47300
- 3) The school will verify that you have a current Home School Declaration of Intent on file with the state.
- 4) Once your residency and DOI have been verified you will be provided with a link to make payment, and instructions for how to register for AP Classroom.

## You MUST complete the online registration form and make payment by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

Please be aware of the following additional requirements:

- If your student requires accommodations, you must apply for them and submit the necessary documentation to the College Board by January 16, 2026. - If you need financial assistance for the exam fee(s), you will need to complete an online application here: https://www.nlappscloud.com/Welcome.aspx?api=5e2c9f030eed71d6a237cb2b8dee25c8
- Your student will need to bring either a photo ID (driver's license, passport, etc.) or a notarized identification form on the day of each test they will be taking.
- Your student will need transportation to and from EPHS on the day of each exam.





- Your student should bring with them a laptop for testing. Bluebook should be downloaded prior to arriving for testing. Click <u>HERE</u> to download Bluebook.
- Your student will need to arrive 1 hour prior to exam start time in order to set up their connection to our school Wifi.

## **Costs and Fees:**

- Each AP exam costs \$105.00.
- Students approved for financial assistance first AP exam (<u>any</u> subject) is free; additional AP exams for students on a free or reduced lunch are \$53.00 each.
- The first STEM exam is free (for <u>any</u> student, regardless of financial assistance status). Current STEM courses are: Biology, Calculus, Statistics, Precalculus, and Chemistry.
- If your AP exam is free (first STEM exam or one free exam for students on a free or reduced lunch), you are still required to pay the deposit of \$ 45.00 because College Board charges \$45 for changes or unused exams.
  - o **If your AP exam is free**, after you take your exam, the deposit will be refunded to you.
- You must be enrolled in AP classroom in order for an exam to be ordered for you. Even if you pay the registration fee, an exam CANNOT be ordered if you are not enrolled in AP classroom.
- Students requiring **financial assistance** must indicate that in Total Registration and **allow 24 hours for that request to be approved.**
