**Who will be tested?**

- All 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Face-to-Face (F2F) & Virtual Learners
- All 9<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> grade students that register and pay on RevTrak

**When will the test be given?**

October 13th @ 8:35AM

**What do I do on test day?**

Report to your testing location immediately upon arrival on campus. Room rosters will be posted in the main hall to direct students to the appropriate testing location. Faculty & staff will also be in the halls to help students find their testing location. Beginning 10/6/21, you may email Carole Pearson at [cpearson@paulding.k12.ga.us](mailto:cpearson@paulding.k12.ga.us) to receive testing room assignments.

As soon as all testers are where they need to be, and no later than 9:00am, testing rooms will close and no one else will be admitted.

The testing schedule will be as follows:

- Administration Duties (Distributing Materials, Bubbling Demographics & Identifying Info, etc.): 45 minutes (approx.)
- Reading Test: 60 minutes
- Break: 5 minutes
- Writing & Language Test: 35 minutes
- Math Test (No Calculator): 25 minutes
- Break: 5 minutes
- Math Test (Calculator): 45 minutes
- Administration Duties (Collecting & Counting Materials): 15 minutes (approx.)
- Total Time: 235 minutes (3 hours & 55 minutes)**

**Except for administration duties, the testing section timing is not flexible. This is a long test and will be a challenge to complete before lunch. Please help us get started as quickly as possible by arriving on time.**

**What do I need to bring with me?**

- Students are encouraged to wear a mask while on the EPHS campus and during testing
- Photo ID: Students unknown to the test examiner or other testing staff may be required to confirm their identify with a photo ID. Examples of Acceptable ID include:
  - Government issued driver's license or nondriver ID card
  - Official school-produced student ID card from the student's current school
  - Government issued passport or U.S. Global Entry ID card
  - Government issued military or national ID card
- Acceptable Calculator for use on the Math – Section 2 test. Please see the list of acceptable calculators below. Note: **EPHS will not provide calculators.** Students wanting access to a calculator during the test must bring their own and turn it in to their test examiner prior to the beginning of the test.

**Cell phones, wearable technology (e.g., smartwatches or fitness trackers), and other electronic devices are not allowed in the testing room.** Students will be provided with a bag to label with their name and to place these items in upon entry into the

testing room. The devices will be collected and removed from the testing room, locked away, and returned to the students at the conclusion of testing.

**Students are not able to enter or exit the testing room once testing begins. If your student needs to leave before the testing room dismisses, his or her test will be invalidated.**

**What should I do when my testing room is dismissed?**

- Virtual Learners and PVA students should exit the front of the building to be picked up once they are released from their testing room
- F2F Learners will follow release instructions provided by their examiner

## Acceptable Calculators

The following calculators are acceptable for use on the Math Test – Calculator. Only this test permits the use of a calculator (unless a student has an approved accommodation). This list doesn't include every calculator model. **Call PSAT/NMSQT Support if you aren't sure about a calculator that's not on this list.**

- All scientific calculators, which can perform complex mathematical functions but don't have a graphing feature, are acceptable as long as they don't have any prohibited features given under Unacceptable Calculators.
- All 4-function calculators are acceptable but not recommended.
- Graphing calculators included in the following table are acceptable.

## Unacceptable Calculators

Students are not allowed to use any of the following calculators, unless specifically approved by College Board as an accommodation:

- Laptops or other computers, tablets, mobile phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology
- Models that can access the internet or have wireless, Bluetooth, cellular, audio/video recording and playing, camera, or any other smartphone-type features
- Models that have a computer-style (QWERTY) keyboard, pen input, or stylus

- Models that use electrical outlets, make noise, or have a paper tape

In addition, the use of hardware peripherals such as a stylus with an approved calculator isn't permitted. Some models with touchscreen capability are not permitted (e.g., Casio ClassPad). Check the list of acceptable graphing calculators above for models that are permitted.
