HOW DO I GET IN?

MUST BE:

- ✓ Junior/Senior
- ✓ On track for graduation
- ✓ 16 or older
- ✓ Have a job and reliable transportation

CRITERIA:

- 2019-2020 school year
 - GPA: 75 or higher
 - 10 unexcused absents or less
 - 10 unexcused tardies or less
 - Clean discipline record
- At least 1 credit in CTAE Course
- On track to graduate
- Have a career goal
- Two positive teacher recommendations required
- Able to provide your own transportation.
- Job by the first day of school (See FAQ)
- Can be a paid or unpaid job

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a job?

Yes, you should have a job by the first week of school. It can be paid or unpaid. However, due to current circumstances we can be flexible.

Can you help me find a job?

Yes. If I get information about companies that are hiring, I will pass it on to you. Ultimately it is your responsibility to find a job.

What is a Career Pathway? You must complete at least 1 CTAE course/or pathway.

Career Pathways: Automotive, Marketing, Healthcare, Business, Personal Care Services, Information Technology, Culinary Arts, Graphic Design, Music, Visual Arts, Forestry/Wildlife Systems

Do I need a car?

You should have reliable transportation and a driver's license OR a reliable person who will take you to work. **You must leave the building during your WBL period.**

How many blocks of Work-Based can I do?

Up to 2 blocks

Do I have to work everyday?

No, but you must work at least 7.5 hours/week for each block class of WBL, and you must leave campus.

Ex. 1 Block = 7.5 hours/week 2 Blocks = 15 hours/week

Can I do Dual Enrollment and Work-Based Learning?

YES! They are a perfect match, since we only meet once a month. You don't have to be on campus (EPHS) every day for WBL.
