HOW DO I GET IN?

MUST BE:

- Junior/Senior by Aug./2019
- On track for graduation
- 16 or older (with valid license)



CRITERIA:

- 2018-2019 school year
 - GPA: 75 or higher
 - 10 unexcused absents or less
 - 10 unexcused tardies or less
 - Clean discipline record
- On track to complete a pathway course
- Have a career goal
- Two positive teacher recommendations required
- Able to provide your own transportation.
- Job by the first day of school
- Can be a paid or unpaid job

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a job?

Yes, you should have a job by the first week of school. It can be paid or unpaid.

Can you help me find a job?

Yes. If I get information about companies that are hiring I will pass it on to you. Ultimately it is your responsibility to find a job.

What is a Career Pathway? We would like your job to match your pathway, but it not required.

Career Pathways: Automotive, Marketing, Healthcare, Business, Personal Care Services, Information Technology, Culinary Arts, Graphic Design, Music, Visual Arts, Forestry/Wildlife Systems

Do I need a car?

You should have reliable transportation and a driver's license OR a reliable person who will take you to work.

How many blocks of Work-Based can I do?

Up to 2 blocks.

Do I have to work everyday?

No, but you must work at least 7.5 hours/week for each block class of WBL, but you must leave campus.

Ex. 1 Block = 7.5 hours/week 2 Blocks = 15 hours/week

Can I do Dual Enrollment and Work-Based Learning?

YES! They are a perfect match, since we only meet once a month. You don't have to be on campus (EPHS) everyday for WBL.
