# School Description:

THE Paulding County High School was established in 1969 following the merger of Dallas High School, the old Hiram High School, and Matthews High School. Within Paulding County High School, is the prestigious and competitive STEM certified Academy of Science, Research, and Medicine, which provides a rigorous curriculum and expansive hands-on opportunities for accepted students that wish to pursue a career within the biotech and medical fields after graduation.

## Community Description:

Paulding County is located 30 miles due northwest of Atlanta and is currently the 3rd fastest growing county in Georgia with a population of 105,936. The Paulding County School System is currently serving approximately 30,000 students among its 19 elementary schools, 9 middle schools, and 5 high schools. In the fall of 2020, Paulding County had approximately 12,000 students participated in virtual learning full time.

### Curriculum Information:

The academic program is organized on daily block schedule. Students take four 90-minute block classes every day. Four credits per semester is the maximum course load. There are two semesters in the August-May year. Credits granted each semester independently.
