

Let's Talk About Lunch

Visitors:

We welcome parents in the building to support our students and staff!

During the first few weeks of school, we do not allow visitors to come for lunch with their students. This will give us time to establish routines and expectations in the cafeteria.

Parents are welcome to start coming to eat lunch with their students starting on Monday, August 28th. This is special for students and parents, so please consider the following things when planning your visit:

Due to the limited spacing, up to 2 adult visitors per student will be allowed.

- Younger siblings can join, but ensure they are supervised at the visitor's table and follow the cafeteria's expectations.
- All visitors must have their license to sign in at the office.
- There are six tables in the rotunda designated for visitors. This allows for two families to sit per table. Only your student can sit with you at the visitor's table. Classroom friends or siblings from other grade levels cannot join at the visitor table due to space.
- Parents are not allowed to sit with the class at their lunch table in the cafeteria.
- If all visitor tables are occupied, you may have to wait for a spot to open. Classes are dismissed three minutes apart. You can stand against the rotunda wall while waiting for a spot to open. This is the only place to wait that will maintain the flow of students. While waiting for a spot to open, your student can go ahead and start eating at their classroom table until a spot is available for them to join you at a visitor table.
- Say hello and goodbye to your student at the visitor's table. Please do not line up with students or walk back to the classroom.
- Outside food and drinks are allowed for your student only. Please do not bring food for other classroom friends.
- Please do not save a spot at the visitor table while waiting for your student to come to the lunchroom. Another visitor may need that spot to eat with their student. You may wait in your car or on the benches outside the office.
- Adult lunches are \$3.70, and tea is \$1.00 if you want to purchase them in the cafeteria.
- No pictures of other students can be taken due to confidentiality.
- If questions or concerns arise, please let the security guard know.

Should we encounter issues with overcrowding, there may be a need for some adjustments and limited visitors.
