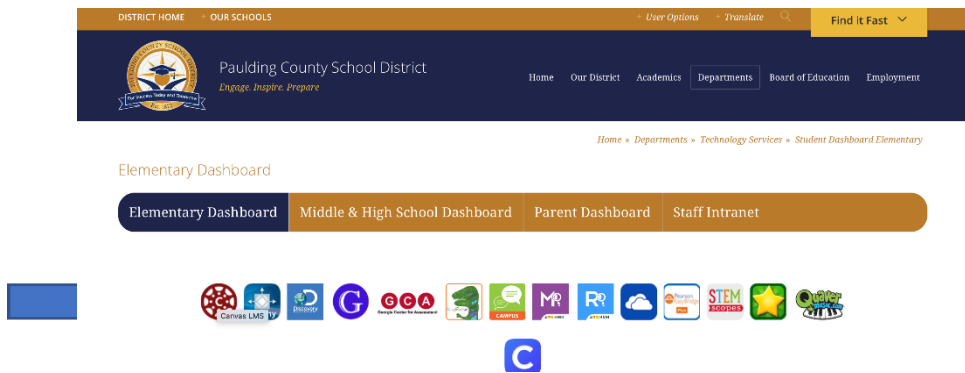


Digital Learning Day Canvas Directions


