Jugs will be set up for each color team on a table outside the counselors' office, and students will be able to drop in coins/bills prior to 8 am OR on their way to specials. "Pennies for Paulding"

Dates for the fund drive: October 29th – November 9th

Pennies for Paulding is a county-wide fund drive that occurs over a ten-day period prior to Thanksgiving. All money goes to Paulding Christmas, Inc., a non-profit organization that provides new toys at Christmas time for approximately 1900 underprivileged children, ages infant to 18 in Paulding County.
