

## **RESOLUTION NO. 21-01**

**WHEREAS**, the Paulding County School District was created by an Act of the Georgia General Assembly; and

**WHEREAS**, the governance of the School District is vested in the hands of the Board of Education duly elected by the people of Paulding County, Georgia; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Brian Otott was appointed by the Paulding County Board of Education to the position of Superintendent of the Paulding County School System in 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Brian Otott's last day as Superintendent of the Paulding County School District shall be May 31, 2021 having served 31 years in the Paulding County School System; and

**WHEREAS**, be it resolved by the Paulding County Board of Education that Dr. Brian Otott be honored and recognized for his longevity, his leadership, and his commitment to the Paulding County School District, its Board of Education, its employees and students and the people of Paulding County, Georgia.
