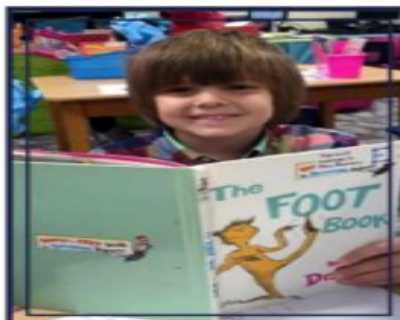
Reading Rocks Paulding is a community engagement campaign to encourage reading by children and adults in Paulding County. There will be monthly themes along with digital engagement opportunities.

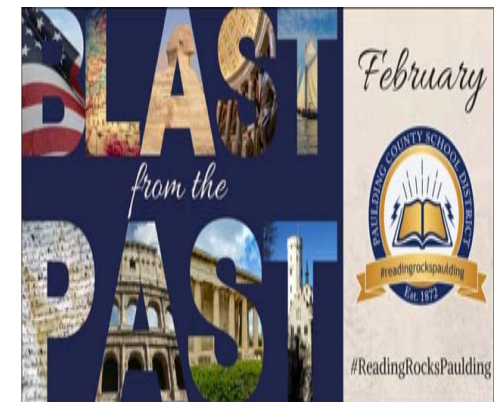

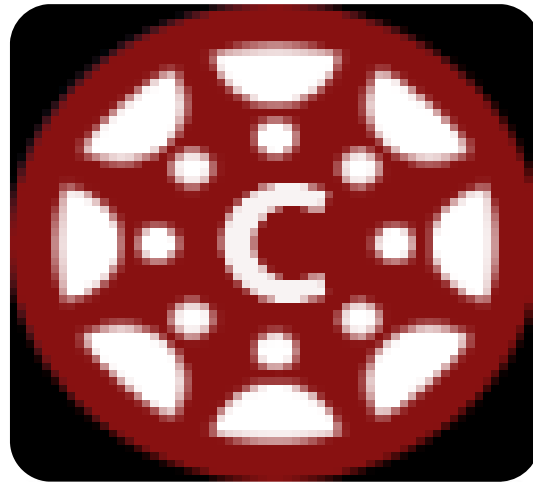
