

How does it work?

Students will use their student ID number to access their PLAY Card account just like they would use a library card. The PLAY Card is free and access to public library resources and services is free.

What can you use?

Students with a PLAY Card can check out up to 5 physical items at a time, including books, DVDs, CDs, free passes to state parks, and more. The PLAY Card will also give your student free access to digital resources such as e-books through Libby and eRead Kids, language learning through Mango Languages, practice tests for SAT, ACT, nursing entrance exams, and more.

What if you don't want a PLAY Card?

If you would prefer your student not to have a PLAY Card, you may opt out of this program by notifying your school.

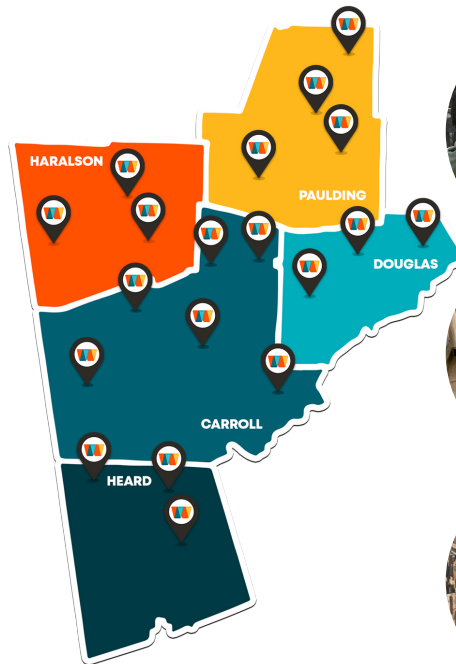
Stream free e-books, e-audiobooks, comics, movies, TV shows, and music on Hoopla. Limited to 4 per month (plus select bonus borrows)
