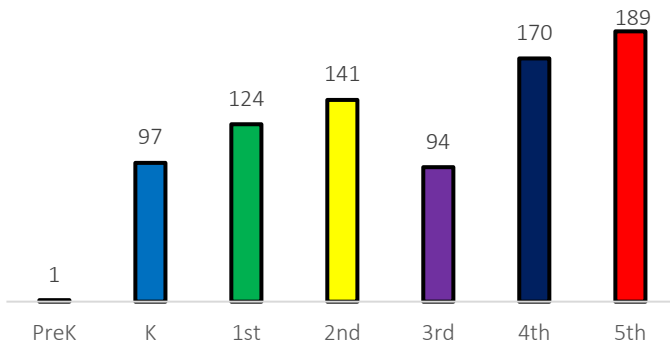

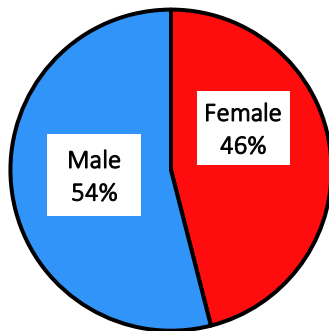

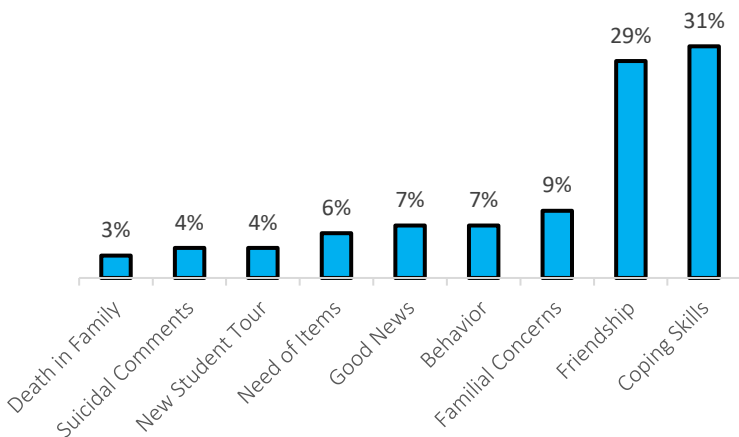
Individual Counseling by Grade Level

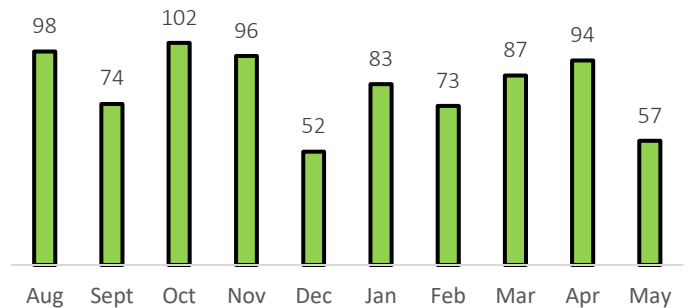
