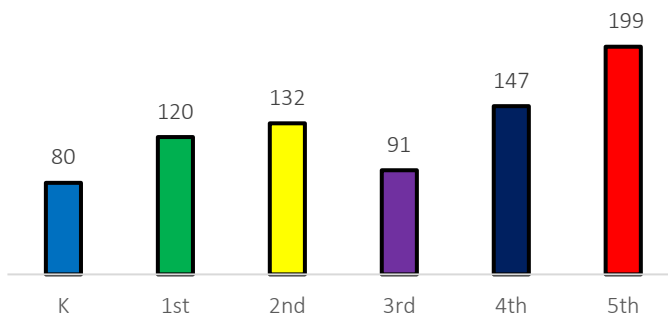

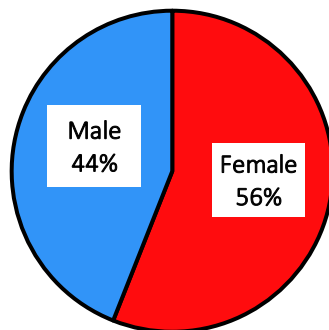

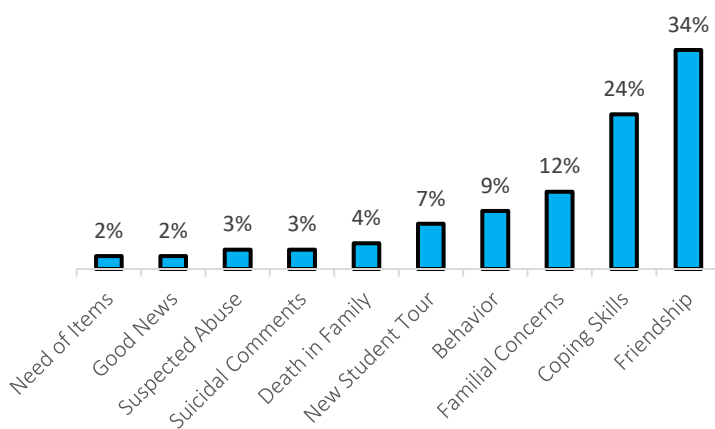
### Individual Counseling by Grade Level

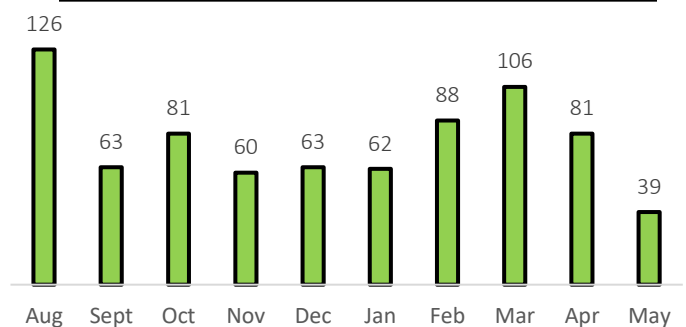
