

## Digital Learning Days – ELA Interventions/Programs

### **Achieve3000 (Middle & High School)**

- Students scheduled in Achieve 3000 courses in IC will have access to the programs software any time of day.
- Students will access the programs via Student Dashboard- Middle-High Dashboard – C (Clever) – Achieve3000.
- Achieve Goals are set for students to complete 2-3 activities per week at a minimum of 75% accuracy.

### **Writeable (HHS, SPHS, Austin, Dobbins only)**

- Students have access to the program through Canvas when assigned by the teacher.
- Teachers assign writing prompts through Canvas by creating an assignment and choosing the program through “External Tools”.
- Each of the four schools above has 900 licenses.
- Writable implementation goals include 2-3 quick writes per week with at least one opportunity for peer feedback.

### **Middle School Turnitin! Revision Assistant (Scoggins, Jones, Ritch, East Middle, McClure only)**

- Revision Assistant is an NBI support product for use with a targeted group of students during NBI.
- Remember that there are license limitations on this program; therefore, it should not be used as a digital learning resource for your entire school.
- License numbers vary; please create a plan that will not exceed your license amount. If you have questions about your licensing, please call Lindsay Hodges.
- Students have access to the program through Canvas when assigned by the teacher.
- Teachers assign writing prompts through Canvas by creating an assignment and choosing the program through “External Tools”.
