

Graduation Credit Checklist

These are the bare minimums required to graduate. Most students will have more credits than are listed below, but these are the minimums. If these credits do not appear, you may be in danger of not graduating.

English – Must have 4 credits

- Ninth Lit
- World Lit / Tenth Lit
- American Lit / AP Lang
- 4th English (Adv. Comp/Brit Lit/AP Lit/DE English)

Social Studies – Must have 3 credits

- World History
- US History
- Economics (1/2 credit)
- Government (1/2 credit)

Science – Must have 4 credits

- Biology
- Chemistry/Environmental Science/Earth Systems
- Physical Science/Physics
- 4th Science (Forensic Science/Zoology/Anatomy/AP Science/Essentials of HC/Animal Sc & Bio, Any listed above)

Math – Must have 4 credits

- Algebra: Concepts and Connections
- Geometry: Concepts and Connections
- Advanced Algebra: Concepts and Connections
- 4th Math (Stat Reasoning/Pre-Cal/Adv Fin Algebra/DE Math) – required for admission to four-year college

Health/PE – Must have 1 credit

- Health and Personal Fitness (1 credit) **Or** 3 credits of JROTC

CTAE*/World Language/Fine Art – Must have 3 full credits in any combination

Grade-Level Promotion

Placement of students in grades ten through twelve is determined by the number of credits earned by the beginning of the school.

- **At least 5** credits must be earned for a student to be considered a sophomore.
- **At least 11** credits must be earned for a student to be considered a junior.
- **At least 17** credits must be earned for a student to be considered a senior.
- **At least 23** credits must be earned for a student to GRADUATE!!!
