Access Information for R180, System 44, and iRead

- Students will have access to Read 180, System 44, and iRead 7 days a week, from 7am-7pm.
- Students will access the programs via Student Dashboard-Elem or Middle High Dashboard – C (Clever) – SAM – Program
- If the students have problems accessing Clever from home, they can use the HMH URL

Read 180 Suggestions

- Student application software
 - Conferencing with students about progress in the software is still recommended
 - 15-20 mins at least 3 times/week
 - Complete a segment every 5-15 sessions
- eBooks
 - Have teachers set goals for completion of eBooks based on the length of the books
 - Book projects can be assigned for the eBooks – search “Final Projects” in the Resource tab of Teacher Central
 - Quiz
- eReads
 - Recommendation is for students to complete at least one eRead every two weeks
 - Quiz
- Digital QuickWrites for eBooks and eReads– submit to the teacher’s assignment board

System 44 Suggestions

- Student application software
 - Conferencing with students about progress in the software is still recommended
 - 15-20 mins/day
 - 2 topics/week
- eBooks
 - Students typically need more support than R180 students, so teacher discretion should be used as to whether students should be assigned these at home
 - If teachers choose to have students complete eBooks at home, we recommend having them submit written accountability through Canvas, if possible

iRead Suggestions

- Student application software
 - 15-20 mins/day
