General Fund Financial Update

Budget. Amended expenditure budget of \$431.6 million, a decrease of \$2.4 million or -0.6%.

Revenue. YTD revenue of \$409.1 million or 94.8% of the annual budget, resulting in a variance to budget of \$13.5 million or 3.1%. **Expenditures**. YTD expenditures of \$385.9 million or 89.4% of the annual budget, resulting in a variance to budget of \$9.7 million or 2.3%.

Fund Balance. YTD revenue exceeds expenditures \$23.2 million and, after other sources and uses, fund balance increased \$16.9 million to \$75.7 million or \$73.9 million unassigned.
