Organizational Excellence

Strategic Plan Update—Dr. Jason Gregaydis, Chief of Staff, presented an update on the Strategic Planning. The presentation included the timeline, tasks and next steps. He thanked the members of the Strategic Planning that includes community members, parents, staff and students.

Grant Budget—Mr. Barnette presented grants that were not included in the original FY22 budget.
