 - On the new page that opens, click the play button to hear the paragraphs read to you.

• To listen from a certain point on the page, select the word and then click the play button.

- Click the Next and Previous page buttons to move between pages.
- The reader will not display images, but will display the text in the images.

- To change the text options,
 - Click the text icon in the top right-hand corner of the immersive reader screen.
 - Move the slider to change the text size.
 - Toggle the Increase Spacing button on or off to increase or decrease the amount of space between letters.

 - Click **Dictate** on the Immersive Reader tab on the ribbon.
 - \circ The first time you use dictation, you'll be asked to sign in with your Office 365 account.
 - Begin speaking when you see the highlighted "Listening" text box.
 - To insert punctuation, say its name (i.e., period, new line, comma, etc.).
 - $\circ\quad$ Click **Dictate** again to stop recording.
