Goals

Goal 1: Students in grades 3rd – 5th grade will achieve a performance level of 5 or 6 on extended writing (purpose and organization, evidence and elaboration) as measured by the GMAS in the Spring of 2026. A score of 5 -6 is grade level proficient and above. Grade level target: 3rd – 45%, 4th – 37%, 5th – 57%.

Goal 2: We will improve our monthly PLC process through guided data analysis to change and differentiate curriculum. By May 2026 the reading status (midpoint of Lexile band) on the GMAS will improve by 3%. Achieving this goal will improve student comprehension. Grade level baseline: 3rd – 73%, 4th – 61%, 5th – 72%

Russom Snapshot

Opened in 2004, Russom Elementary School is located in the northern part of Paulding County Georgia. Russom is one of the four largest elementary schools in the county, out of a total of nineteen elementary schools. The school is ranked in the top 20% of Georgia elementary schools with a rating of 9/10 based on test data. Russom Elementary School is a safe, inviting learning environment where staff, students and parents demonstrate mutual respect. The learning process is enhanced by a multitude of instructional resources, technology and parental and community involvement. Our classrooms encourage cooperative learning, producing quality work, and self-assessment. Our climate star rating is an evaluation of the school's environment, focusing on safety, relationships, and conditions that support student learning.

Demographics

Russom has 950 students with 4th grade as our largest grade level and 1st as our smallest. Our race ethnicity is composed of 51% white, 21% black, 15% Hispanic, 7% Asian, 6% and 6% multiracial. 36% of our students are on a free or reduced cost lunch.
