**Grant Award Notification for CTAE— Approved** the receipt of FY2025 CTAE Perkins Program Improvement grant funding was presented.

**Policy GARH: Employee Leaves and Absences—Approved** the revision to Policy GARH: Employee Leaves and Absences was presented.

**IFB 24-230718 Tires and Retreads—Approved** to renew Invitation for Bid (IFB) 24-230718 Tires and Retreads to Atlanta Commercial Tire, Forest Park, Georgia. This award will be for the period beginning October 2024 through September 2025 was presented. This is the first of four one-year renewal terms. For purchases based on District needs and subject to budget limitations. FY2024 tentative budget of \$131,000.

**Radio System Tower - Poole ES—Approved** the Easement Agreement with Paulding County for the installation of a Radio System Emergency Communications Tower at Poole Elementary School was presented.

**Radio System Tower - Allgood ES—Approved** the Easement Agreement with Paulding County for the installation of a Radio System Emergency Communications Tower at Allgood Elementary School was presented.

**GDOT Land and Easement Purchase—Approved** the sale of approximately 0.376 acres of land and 0.503 acres of permanent easement to the Georgia Department of Transportation for a sum of \$191,716, subject to final legal review was presented.

**IFB 23-220916 Retrofit A/C for Blue Bird Buses - Approved** to renew Invitation for Bid (IFB) 23-220916 A/C Retrofit for Blue Bird Buses to Yancey Brothers Company, Austell, Georgia. This renewal award will be for the period beginning October 2024 through September 2025. This is the first of two, one-year options for renewal. For purchases based on District needs and subject to budget limitations. FY2025 tentative budget of \$383,671.

## Action

**Construction Management-at-Risk Services - Poole ES—Approved** to award Request for Proposal (RFP) 24-240619 Construction Management-at-Risk Services to SmithBuilt Construction Group, Alpharetta, Georgia for the renovation and modification of Poole Elementary School was presented. This project will have a separate contract, to be approved by the Board of Education, and may be eligible for state capital project outlay funding. For solicitation purposes, the total construction cost for this project was estimated at \$5,400,000.

**Construction Management-at-Risk Services - Elementary School #20—Approved** to award Request for Proposal (RFP) 25-240701 Construction Management-at-Risk Services to R.K. Redding Construction, Inc., Bremen, Georgia for the construction of ES #20 was presented. This project will have a separate contract, to be approved by the Board of Education, and may be eligible for state capital project outlay funding. For solicitation purposes, the total construction cost for this project was estimated at \$29,000,000.
