Presentations

PCSD Graduation Rate— Dr. Otott presented an overview of the 2019 Graduation Rate and Data. The overall graduation rate was 88.8%. For students that were enrolled in Paulding County from 9th through 12th grade, the graduation rate was 91.2%. The District ranked **5th** for districts with graduating class sizes above 1000 and ranked **3rd** for districts with graduating class sizes above 2000.

Financial Report for August 2019 — Steve Barnette presented the August 2019 financial report. Revenues \$35.0 million, expenditures \$49.8 million and the unassigned fund balance \$27.1 million.

ITB 20-190910 Tires and Retreads—Approved with Atlanta Commercial Tire, Forest Park, Georgia for an initial term beginning October 23, 2019 through September 30, 2020 at the cost of \$120,000 annually.

ITB 20-190802— Approved with Jaxx Pest Control Services, Acworth, Georgia for an initial term beginning October 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 at the cost of \$67,000 annually.

Revision to Policy DJED: Bids and Quotations—Approved to align policy to industry norms and best practices, moves superfluous language to procurement procedures, provides clarifying language and increase select thresholds to improve procurement efficiency.

Rescind Policy IDCH: Dual Enrollment—Approved as all points in the policy are part of the updated SBOE Policy IDCH that was adopted June 13, 2019. Georgia School Board Association guidance recommends to rescind existing policy and rely on the dual enrollment rule and related materials available on the [SBOE website](#).

Greystone Power Easement—Approved the Right of Way Easement with GreyStone Power for electrical service to the new marquee at P.B. Ritch Middle School.

The purpose of this contract is to provide onsite automotive, truck, bus parts and parts inventory and management at repair facilities. Key benefits of the contract include onsite NAPA Parts Store, NAPA profit margin capped at 7.5%, single supplier for auto, truck, bus and other equipment parts, real time parts availability, and inventory and parts management program option available (eliminates inventory and associated costs).
