

# Reading Connections Syllabus



## **Standards:**

Students will read and analyze a variety of texts using the computer-based program, *READ 180*. Students will strengthen skills in phonics/word recognition, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and writing on an *individualized* basis.

Additionally, students will annotate texts, relate them to other texts, and cite textual evidence.
